The 7 Days of Creation, & the 7 Feasts of the Lord Mean We Absolutely Can KNOW the DAY & the HOUR

## #1

# God **spoke** the world into existence. He did not need billions of years. The **Word** is crystal clear on this.

- Spoiler alert the world isn't billions of years old don't even insult God by believing atheist scientists instead of God's Word. HE SPOKE and it was created! End of story. He did NOT need time. He is beyond time.
- This is so important to understand the TIMELINE of HUMAN History - we only have 7000 years to believe before Paradise is FOUND and hell is forever. But more details on this in Lesson #2, so please study that also.
- The Big Bang theory is a total Satanic lie! Totally made up during the *Enlightenment* period during the mid 1800s when people were sick of the oppression and tyranny of the Roman Catholic Church and wanted to free people from false "religion" and to focus on science. It was intentional. When Darwin wrote his made up thesises, it was accepted by the masses because they hated the false apostate church!

- You did not create the universe. God did. That
  means He is way smarter than you. He is perfect
  LOVE. The Bible shows this clearly when you read
  it straight through the first time. It is so brilliant, so
  beyond us, it truly takes your breath away.
  That is, if you have a HEART to hear truth.

### The **7 Days of Creation** give us **7000 Years** of Human History

- As we saw in Lesson #2, Scripture clearly tells us two things about OUR TIMELINE before we are reunited in paradise with God for eternity. 1) That the 7 Days of Creation are literal 24-hr periods as told to us in Genesis 1 and 2, and that 2) To the Lord, a 24-hr period or day to us, is 1000 years to Him. We are told this by Moses in Psalm 90 and Peter in 2 Peter 3.
- We also know from verses like Hosea 6:2 that prophesy
  Jesus will come back in 2 days or 2000 years. So, since
  He died in 30 AD that means He must come back in
  2030, which is lining up perfectly with world events.
- And Revelation 20 tells us clearly that He reigns for 1000 years in the Millennium reign as King of the Jews.
- Take time to really study the Timelines and dates and see for yourself how perfectly the Bible lays this out.





## The 7 Feasts of the Lord gives us the exact DAYS Jesus returns

- As the 7 Days of Creation tell us the Timeline of Human History is 7000 years in total, the 7 Feasts of the Lord mentioned throughout the Bible give us the Prophetic Timeline of the exact DAY Jesus must return - first for His Bride, the true Church, (the Rapture) and then for Israel, God's beloved (the Second Coming to reign as King of the Jews in Jerusalem).
- Let's look at the Biblical history and the PROPHETIC REASON God instituted the Feasts, that HE calls the FEASTS OF THE LORD in Leviticus 23.
- Remember, before God allows anyone to go to hell, He warns and warns and tells us exactly.
- God told Noah that it was going to rain in exactly 7 Days. (Genesis 7:4) He didn't say you can't know, Noah. NO! He said Noah, it's going to rain in exactly 7 days and it did.

- In Acts 1:11, it gives us this clue that when Jesus rose for the final time, His disciples were watching Him go up to heaven. Two angels appeared to them and said this -"Men of Galilee, why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen Him go into heaven."
- In John 14:1, Jesus tells His disciples that He must go prepare a room for them in His Father's house, but that He will come back for them (representing true believers) at some point to take them to be with Him in His Father's house in heaven. These two verses tell us that Jesus will come back in the same way He last left and will take us to be with Him, in heaven.
- But in Revelation 19, it tells us He comes back on a White Horse as the Conquering King of the Jews with His bride on white horses to touch down on earth and reign in Jerusalem for 1000 years. (Revelation 20). So, we know there are TWO COMINGS because they are described quite differently in the Scriptures and yet both must be fulfilled. Clear proof the *Rapture* and *Second Coming* are two different events.

- So there are TWO DAYS we need to find in Scripture that will tell us when these EXACT DAYS will be.
- Prophecy is Pattern in the Bible. Every story in the Old Testament is a literal historical event AND foreshadows to a future PROPHETIC event.
- Throughout the Old Testament we have many verses like this Isaiah 53:7 "He was oppressed, and He was afflicted, yet He didn't open His mouth; like a lamb that is led to the slaughter." And then we read the same in 1 Peter 1:19 "But with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without blemish or spot."
- And we know Jesus was killed on Feast of Passover as the sacrificial lamb. God told us many times this was going to happen - not on a day that we wouldn't know but on an exact day He told us in advance that Jesus would do something.
- ALL 7 Feasts of the Lord must be satisfied by Jesus on the EXACT DAY. That's what a loving Father does.

### Moadim

The Hebrew word for "feasts or festivals" is moadim and literally means the *appointed times*. God has carefully planned the timing and sequence of His 7 Feasts, not just for the nation of Israel, but for all of us, as they tell us exactly what Christ will do on what day. Hallelujah! Thank you, Father!

- God rescues the new Israeli nation that had grown to millions since the time of Joseph from slavery in Egypt at the start of the book of Exodus. We all know the story of the parting of the Red Sea and Moses saying, "Let my people go."
- We see the first hint that God has *PROPHETIC CALENDAR* when He tells the Israelites to remember THIS DAY and to celebrate it always in Exodus 13.
- When we fast forward to the New Testament and realize that Christ died on the *Feast of Passover* as the sacrificial lamb, we begin to see that every event, every name, number, city, etc. in the Bible is not only an historical event, but FORESHADOWS Christ and events that would happen in *End Times*.
- As I recorded the entire Bible for www.thebibleinayear.tv and had to understand every detail to explain it, I was forever changed to love, love the parts of the Bible - like genealogies and feast days - that appear boring but are absolutely telling us important dates we can put our hope in, especially as we live in these evil last days.

- Jesus fulfills the Lord's Feasts throughout history at His FIRST Coming as the Sacrifical Lamb, at the Rapture of His Bride as Our Loving Husband and at His SECOND Coming for Israel as the Conquering King, to reign as King of the Jews in the Millennium kingdom for 1000 years.
- The prophet Amos tells us as all of Scripture screams to us

   that God said He would not do anything without first
   revealing it to His servants, the prophets. (Amos 3:7) That is
   what a loving, merciful God does that does not want one to
   perish.
- This is why God was telling us in Genesis 1 that all of human history from the *fall* of Adam and Eve when sin entered the world would be 6000 years (*foreshadowed in the 6 days of creation*) after which Jesus would come reign for 1000 years of *Sabbath rest* (why it is so important to God we honor the weekly 7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath), so all of life in this fallen world would be 7000 years on this earth before it is destroyed and the New Heaven and New Earth come down and we are back in Paradise with Him forever.

And then why by the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> book of the Bibles Exodus and Leviticus - He gives us HIS APPOINTED
 TIMES, which prophetically POINT TO JESUS!!!

And God said, "Let there be lights in the vault of the sky to separate the day from the night, and let them serve as signs to mark sacred times, and days and years, and let them be lights in the vault of the sky to give light on the earth." And it was so. God made two great lights the greater light to govern the day and the lesser light to govern the night. He also made the stars. God set them in the vault of the sky to give light on the earth, to govern the day and the night, and to separate light from darkness. And God saw that it was good. And there was evening, and there was morning - the fourth day.


### The Jewish Harvest **Schedule** was established by the God of **Order**

- As you will see in the details of each Feast, they are tied to the HARVEST cycles and crops in Israel. God is not only our Great Provider and a Practical God who has told us how to order our society and how to harvest our food from the ground and plants and animals HE gave us, but HE is a God who tells us the END from the BEGINNING and how we will get back to the GARDEN TO LIVE IN HIS PRESENCE.
- A loving God must warn and tell us the details of how and when we can get back to Him! He does this on every page of the Bible and gives us details about HIS PROPHETIC CALENDAR in Genesis 1! And then confirms it and sprinkles clues and more details about it throughout the entire Bible.

### Leviticus 23

The LORD said to Moses, Speak to the Israelites and say to them: These are **MY** appointed times, the appointed feasts of the LORD, which you are to proclaim as sacred assemblies.

### The Jewish Harvest Season



- The 7 Feasts of the LORD were put into place to point to prophetic events, to give us the exact timeline of all of human history from the fall of man until Satan would be bound and all would be back in the Garden with God. All 7 Feasts are about JESUS and will be satisfied by Jesus Himself on the exact day the Bible tells us to celebrate these sacred assemblies.
- They, like the 7 days of Creation, are telling us far more than a past historical event. They start the sacred calendar that Yahweh (aka God the Father, the God of Israel) not only established for His people the Israelites but all nations and people as the Israelites were supposed to be a light to the world to bring them into the One True God. We know they failed miserably at this, even killing the Messiah, which is why God then used the Church made up of Jew and Gentile.

- The 1<sup>st</sup> month on the Jewish calendar is the month of Nisan in SPRING, which is determined by the first conjunction of the moon after the vernal equinox. The sacred calendar is thus aligned with the seasons and the harvests of the crops (or people) necessary for the Feasts, as God is always thinking of His people and being their Great Provider.
- The first 3 Feasts are in the 1<sup>st</sup> month in SPRING
- The <u>last</u> 3 Feasts of the harvest calendar year are in the last month of the harvest calendar - the 7<sup>th</sup> month - in the FALL.
- This is so prophetically significant and screaming at us from the beginning of the Israeli nation and the *First Coming of Christ* to the exact timeline of End of Times and *Christ's Second Coming* and the start of the Millennium.

 The 4<sup>th</sup> Feast - in the very middle - the Feast of Pentecost is in the SUMMER and is set apart from the others because it is the only feast that represents both ISRAEL AND the CHURCH.

### The Appointed Feasts



23 The LORD said to Moses, <sup>2</sup> "Speak to the Israelites and say to them: 'These are my appointed festivals, the appointed festivals of the LORD, which you are to proclaim as sacred assemblies.



### The Sabbath WEEKLY Appointed Times

<sup>3</sup> "There are six days when you may work, but the seventh day is a day of sabbath rest, a day of sacred assembly. You are not to do any work; wherever you live, it is a sabbath to the LORD.



The Passover and the Festival of Unleavened Bread ANNUAL Feast #1 & 2

4 "'These are the LORD's appointed festivals, the sacred assemblies you are to proclaim at their appointed times: 5 The LORD's Passover begins at twilight on the fourteenth day of the first month. 6 On the fifteenth day of that month the LORD's Festival of Unleavened Bread begins; for seven days you must eat bread made without yeast. <sup>7</sup> On the first day hold a sacred assembly and do no regular work. <sup>8</sup> For seven days present a food offering to the LORD. And on the seventh day hold a sacred assembly and do no regular work."



Offering the Firstfruits ANNUAL Feast #3

<sup>9</sup> The LORD said to Moses, <sup>10</sup> "Speak to the Israelites and say to them: 'When you enter the land I am going to give you and you reap its harvest, bring to the priest a sheaf of the first grain you harvest. 11 He is to wave the sheaf before the LORD so it will be accepted on your behalf; the priest is to wave it on the day after the Sabbath. 12 On the day you wave the sheaf, you must sacrifice as a burnt offering to the LORD a lamb a year old without defect, 13 together with its grain offering of two-tenths of an ephah of the finest flour mixed with olive oil—a food offering presented to the LORD, a pleasing aroma—and its drink offering of a quarter of a hin of wine. 14 You must not eat any bread, or roasted or new grain, until the very day you bring this offering to your God. This is to be a lasting ordinance for the generations to come, wherever you live.



<sup>15</sup> "From the day after the Sabbath, the day you brought the sheaf of the wave offering, count off seven full weeks. <sup>16</sup> Count off fifty days up to the day after the seventh Sabbath, and then present an offering of new grain to the Lord. <sup>17</sup> From wherever you live, bring two loaves made of two-tenths of an ephah of the finest flour, baked with yeast, as a wave offering of firstfruits to the Lord. <sup>18</sup> Present with this bread seven male lambs, each a year old and without defect, one young bull and two rams. They will be a burnt offering to the Lord, together with their grain offerings and drink offerings—a food offering, an aroma pleasing to the Lord. <sup>19</sup> Then sacrifice one male goat for a sin offering and two lambs, each a year old, for a fellowship offering. <sup>20</sup> The priest is to wave the two lambs before the Lord as a wave offering, together with the bread of the firstfruits. They are a sacred offering to the Lord for the priest. <sup>21</sup> On that same day you are to proclaim a sacred assembly and do no regular work. This is to be a lasting ordinance for the generations to come, wherever you live.

<sup>22</sup> "When you reap the harvest of your land, do not reap to the very edges of your field or gather the gleanings of your harvest. Leave them for the poor and for the foreigner residing among you. I am the LORD your God."



<sup>23</sup> The LORD said to Moses, <sup>24</sup> "Say to the Israelites: 'On the first day of the seventh month you are to have a day of sabbath rest, a sacred assembly commemorated with trumpet blasts. <sup>25</sup> Do no regular work, but present a food offering to the LORD."



<sup>26</sup> The LORD said to Moses, <sup>27</sup> "The tenth day of this seventh month is the Day of Atonement. Hold a sacred assembly and deny yourselves, and present a food offering to the LORD. 28 Do not do any work on that day, because it is the Day of Atonement, when atonement is made for you before the LORD your God. <sup>29</sup> Those who do not deny themselves on that day must be cut off from their people. <sup>30</sup> I will destroy from among their people anyone who does any work on that day. <sup>31</sup> You shall do no work at all. This is to be a lasting ordinance for the generations to come, wherever you live. <sup>32</sup> It is a day of sabbath rest for you, and you must deny yourselves. From the evening of the ninth day of the month until the following evening you are to observe your sabbath."



33 The LORD said to Moses, 34 "Say to the Israelites: 'On the fifteenth day of the seventh month the LORD's Festival of Tabernacles begins, and it lasts for seven days. 35 The first day is a sacred assembly; do no regular work. 36 For seven days present food offerings to the LORD, and on the eighth day hold a sacred assembly and present a food offering to the LORD. It is the closing special assembly; do no regular work.

### Leviticus 23

gives us the practical historical celebrations of the Lord's feasts. Now let's look at the *prophetic* fulfillment in Jesus.

### Colossians 2

Therefore, do not let anyone judge you by what you eat or drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day. These are a **shadow of the things that were to come**; the reality, however, is **found in Christ**.



## Jesus did not miss one Feast when He was on the earth. Powerful.

- Jesus celebrated all 7 Feasts while He was alive on earth for 33.5 years. We have Scripture to testify to this.
- In addition, the disciples and Paul and the church for 100s of years after Jesus celebrated the Feasts and the weekly Saturday Sabbath, until it was outlawed and they were killed for doing so because of the evil Catholic Church.
- Here are some verses that testify to this
  - Luke 2:40-43
  - Luke 22:7-8
  - Luke 22:14-15
  - Matthew 28:1-2, 6
  - Acts 1
  - John 7:1-10, John 7:37-38
  - Mark 1:21 ; Mark 6:2
  - Matthew 24:30-31 when He comes back on Feast of Trumpets

## #6

The Bible tells us throughout the exact HOUR events happened. And since everything foreshadows Jesus and End Times, we CAN know the HOUR.

- Why would God tell us exact hours in only 66 books that were to last for all human history and speak to every nation, tribe, tongue, age and culture IF they didn't MEAN SOMETHING TO US? He wouldn't! God doesn't waste words for flowery detail. He uses every letter and dot and tittle (whatever that is ③) to tell us what is going to happen in the FUTURE so we KNOW it was HIM and not Satan!!!! That is what a Perfect, Loving Father does!
- Look what Jesus says in Matthew 5:18 "For truly I tell you, until heaven and earth disappear, not even the smallest detail of God's law will disappear until its purpose is achieved."
- The hours mentioned in the Bible have a specific purpose!
- Here are some verses that testify to this -
  - Psalm 119:62 David saying he will rise at midnight
  - Matthew 25:6 Jesus saying the wedding guests will rise at midnight

- Here are some more verses that testify to this about midnight, which I believe Jesus comes back at midnight for the Rapture of His Bride!
- Paul and Silas were broken out of prison at midnight foreshadowing the rapture of true believers. Acts 16:25
- Job telling us the wicked who are left behind come out at midnight because they love the dark. Job 24:17
- Moses telling us God told Him He was going to kill the Egyptian babies at midnight but spare the Israelites who had blood on their doors. Exodus 11:4
- At midnight Paul prayed and saved all 276 men on the ship. Acts 27:27
- Jesus telling us about the prayer of the persistent widow at midnight is what made the judge give her what she wanted. Luke 11:5
- And I could go on and on that Jesus died on the cross at 3pm the 9<sup>th</sup> hour etc, etc. Do a Bible search for 3pm, 9<sup>th</sup> hour, etc. and see how much God tells us exact hours and times as foreshadows of what HE will do in the future in our times since we are in the last days to let us know it was HIM and HIS WORD IS BEING FULFILLED!!!

### Feast #1 - Passover (Pesach):

#### Points to Jesus our Sacrificial Lamb

In Hebrew, the word is **Pesach** means to **pass over** 

- SPRING 14th of Nisan the 1st Month at twilight
- God starts the Jewish calendar with *Passover* and rescuing the Israelites out of 400 years of slavery from Pharaoh and Egypt and takes them to the Promise Land, making them into a great nation as He promised Abraham in Genesis 12.
- Exodus 11-13; Leviticus 23:4-5
- Historical significance for Israel
   Redemption from slavery and Egyptian bondage and God Himself taking them to His Promise Land.
- They were told to kill a lamb and put the blood on their doors so the Angel of Death would "passover" their homes and not kill their babies. All the Egyptian babies were killed, but none of the Jews'.

- Jesus Messianic Fulfillment
   The first Passover with Moses taking the Israelites out of Egypt was a clue or *foreshadow* or first revealing of the MYSTERY of GOD that HIS SON JESUS would satisfy ALL of HIS 7 FEASTS to show the world HIS power and
- That only by BLOOD can sins be forgiven and animals were temporary, Jesus' blood is FINAL and paid for all sins for all time.

HIS plan for redemption.

- Jesus was crucified on April 6<sup>th</sup>, 30 AD on *Passover*,
   which was a THURSDAY, not a FRIDAY another lie the
   Catholic Church has been telling us all of these years.
   And took all of the sin of all of human history on His
   shoulders so we wouldn't have to.
- Jesus was born in a manger hinting to that sacrificial lamb - visited by shepherds and led to slaughter all so we wouldn't have to.

When John the Baptist sees Jesus, he proclaims – "Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world."

- John 1:29

Since you call on a Father who judges each person's work impartially, live out your time as foreigners here in reverent fear. ## Feast #2 - Feast of Unleavened Bread (Hag Ha-Matzot):

### Points to Jesus as the Only One Sinless who could pay for ALL sin

In Hebrew, *Hag Ha-Matzot* means *religious feast* (as distinguished from other festivals) of *unleavened bread* (what matzo bread is)

- SPRING 15<sup>th</sup> 21<sup>st</sup> of Nisan a 7-day feast 1<sup>st</sup> Month so God continues to want the Israelites coming out of slavery to meet with God and make this a priority as they start their year, so they always remember who their God is and that it is YAHWEH who atones for their sin. This starts for 7 days the day after Passover. And was the 1<sup>st</sup> of 3 Feasts that the Jews had to travel to the Temple in Jerusalem to celebrate.
- Exodus 12-13; Leviticus 23:6-8
- Historical significance for Israel Purging the sin out of their lives. In the Bible, *leaven or yeast* represents SIN and so God wanted them to make their bread quickly and without yeast to remind them that GOD rescued them out of Egypt while Pharaoh and his army were pursuing them.
- As they obeyed and hurried and made bread without yeast, God parted the Red Sea to allow them to escape.
   So the Feast of Unleavened bread reminds them every year that if they OBEY God completely, they will not only survive, but see His hand do miracle after miracle on their behalf.

- Jesus Messianic Fulfillment The first Feast of
   Unleavened Bread was a clue or foreshadow that only
   Jesus could take all of our sins on Himself because He
   was the ONLY ONE SINLESS (without the yeast of sin)
   who would be willing to die a brutal, torturous, painful,
   death so we wouldn't have to.
- This pointed to Jesus in the grave during the first days of the Feast, as a seed that has to die and be planted to pay for sin and burst forth as the Bread of Life.
- Jesus was crucified on April 6<sup>th</sup>, 30 AD on *Passover* and experienced death and Hades the next day on the *Feast of Unleavened Bread*, and took all of the *sin* of all of human history on His shoulders so we wouldn't have to. He was the ONLY ONE WHO WAS SINLESS! NO, evil Catholic Church, Mary is not sinless, she was a human just like all the rest of us. Jesus paid the price once and for all for SIN by HIS BLOOD and by death. The animal sacrifices were just a foreshadow of what was coming.

Your boasting is not good.

Don't you know that

a little yeast (sin) destroys
the whole batch of dough?
Get rid of the old yeast (sin),
so that you may be a
new unleavened batch—
as you really are.
For Christ, our Passover Lamb,
has been sacrificed.

- 1 Corinthians 5:6-8

## Feast #3 - Feast of Firstfruits (Yom Habikkurim):

Points to Jesus being the firstfruit to raise from the dead as He always models for us what we must do

In Hebrew, **Yom Habikkurim** means day of firstfruits

- SPRING the 1<sup>st</sup> Month first Sunday after Passover so
  God continues to want the Israelites coming out of slavery
  to meet with God and make this a priority as they start their
  year and harvest seasons, knowing God not themselves
  or anyone else is their Great Provider.
- This also prophetically shows the timing and separation of the 1<sup>st</sup> 3 feasts in the FIRST MONTH OF THE YEAR - His 1<sup>st</sup> Coming as the Sacrificial Lamb - and the last 3 feasts in the LAST MONTH OF THE YEAR - the Conquering King.
- God is *holiness* and *holiness* is the number 3 in the Bible which is why Leviticus is the 3<sup>rd</sup> book.
- Historical significance for Israel To bring the very first of the harvest to the Lord - the first signs of budding and life to ask the Lord to bless the rest of the harvest. They were not to eat any of the new grain until the very day they brought an offering to God and asked God to bless it.
- This was at the *BARLEY* harvest the first and least. The 2<sup>nd</sup> big harvest is the *WHEAT* harvest in Summer and then the 3<sup>rd</sup> big one is the *GRAPE* and *FIG* harvest in Fall, all of which have profound prophetic meaning.

- The *Feast of Firstfruits* is 1 of 3 Jewish harvest feasts to thank and honor God for all that HE provided.
- Leviticus 23:9-14; Deuteronomy 26
- Jesus Messianic Fulfillment Jesus rose from the dead after the Sabbath (Saturday) on SUNDAY - the FIRST DAY OF THE WEEK. Or the 8<sup>th</sup> day, which is the number of new beginnings - why there were only 8 people who got on the Ark, Noah and 7 others. Feast of Firstfruits is ALWAYS on a Sunday (the rebellious Jews make it whatever day which is why they are in sin and go through the Tribulation.
- He was the first to resurrect. Now, we True Believers who
  are the Bride of Christ can be the second on Feast of
  Pentecost. First, true believers the Bride of Christ at the
  Rapture and then the Jews who believe at His Second
  Coming.

- Jesus rose at the BARLEY harvest the first and least.
   Believers will be raptured at the WHEAT harvest why believers are always referred to as wheat in the NT.
- The 3<sup>rd</sup> major harvest in Israel in the Fall is the *GRAPE AND FIG* when Israel will finally believe and receive her Messiah. Where the term *Grapes of Wrath* came from and Israel is always symbolized as the *Fig Tree* in Scripture.

But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the *firstfruits* of those who have fallen asleep. For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive. But each in turn: Christ, the firstfruits; then, when HE COMES. those who belong to Him.

- 1 Corinthians 15:20-23

Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, He cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over Him. The death He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life He lives, He lives to God. In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. Therefore, do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires.

- Romans 6:8-12

# Feast #4 - Feast of Pentecost or Feast of Weeks (Shavout):

Points to Jesus Coming for the Bride of Christ being taken up before God's Wrath on the world - Jews and the Wicked, and joining Jesus in our Mansions in Heaven

In Hebrew, **Shavout** means "weeks" and has to do with counting the omer for 50 days

- <u>SUMMER 50 Days after the Feast of Firstfruits</u> usually falls in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Month. Since Feast of Firstfruits is always on a Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> day of the week you count 7 weeks, which is 49 days and would take you to the Sabbath and then add a day, so it too is always on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the week Sunday. Pentecost in Greek means fifty (50). Shavout in Hebrew means weeks. It is the holiday known in Israel as Counting the Omer.
- Exodus 34:22; Leviticus 23;
- Historical significance for Israel Again, this was the second major
   Feast that the Jews were to show up to the Temple and pray over
   the harvest and bring evidence of the harvest to the Lord to ask for
   His blessing on the rest of the harvest.
- This was the WHEAT harvest and, therefore, they were to bring two loaves of bread - with yeast - to the Temple to dedicate to the Lord.
   This was the only Feast that they were to bring bread with YEAST, which sets it apart for a different meaning.
- This was the 2<sup>nd</sup> of 3 harvest feasts the Jews had to thank and honor God for all that HE provided. This was also the 2<sup>nd</sup> festival that the Jews had to travel to the Temple in Jerusalem, which is prophetically telling.

- Jesus Messianic Fulfillment Just like Christ was the first to raise
  as an offering to the Lord, so His Bride True Believers will rise at
  the Rapture as an offering to the Lord.
- The fact this feast is about wheat and true believers are referred to as wheat in the Bible, and the fact Moses told them to bring two loaves of leavened bread, we know that this means it is about Jew and Gentile as that is what makes up the true Bride of Christ today.
- Jesus told His followers that He was going to die, but said don't worry I am going to prepare a place for YOU and if I GO to prepare a place for YOU, then I will come back and take YOU to IT! (John 14).
- He is the one that has to come back and satisfy the Feast of Pentecost, which HE will do on the Feast of Pentecost – the wheat harvest!!! Like the Law to Israel, the Holy Spirit was just a DEPOSIT. The Holy Spirit did NOT satisfy this Feast as most Pastors wrongly presume because they do not know the Word. Jesus alone has to satisfy all 7 Feasts Himself, as the King of the Jews and the Savior of the World.

Celebrate the Festival of Weeks with the firstfruits of the **wheat** harvest.

- Exodus 34:22

According to the Lord's Word, we tell you that we who are still alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will certainly not precede those who have fallen asleep. For the Lord Himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air.

And so we will be with the Lord forever.

Therefore, encourage one another with these words.


- 1 Thessalonians 4:15-18

For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive. But each in his own turn: Christ, the firstfruits; then, when HE comes (aka Rapture), those who belong to HIM. Then, the end will come, when He hands over the kingdom to God, the Father, after He has destroyed all dominion, authority and power.

- 1 Corinthians 15:22-24

I do not want you to be ignorant of this mystery, brothers and sisters, so that you may not be conceited; Israel has experienced a hardening in part until the full number of the Gentiles has come in, and in this way all Israel will be saved.

- Romans 11:25-26



 It upsets me so that Pastors do NOT know the Bible and therefore confuse the heck out of their sheep. The HOLY SPIRIT did NOT satisfy Pentecost. He is NOT JESUS. He is the Spirit of God that is our Comforter and Counselor – John 14-15 - as a DEPOSIT until Jesus comes back for us.

In My Father's house are many dwelling places; if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you. If I go to prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also. And you now the way where I am going. I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever; that is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive because it does not see Him or know Him, but you know Him because He abides with you and in you. I will not leave you as orphans, I will come to you.

- John 14:2-4, 16-18

## Feast #5 - Feast of Trumpets (Yom Teruah):

Points to Jesus returning as the Conquering King of the Jews when trumpets were blown in Israel to coronate their king, go into battle, etc.

In Hebrew, **Yom Teruah** means "Day of Trumpets"

- FALL 1<sup>st</sup> Day of Tishrei the 7<sup>th</sup> Month God ends the sacred harvest calendar with the final 3 Feasts which all take place in the first 15 days of the month.
- The *Feast of Trumpets* is God telling His people to rest, to celebrate the goodness of God and to enjoy the bounty of their harvests. It isn't a suggestion but a command.
- Numbers 10; Leviticus 23; Joshua 6
- Historical significance for Israel God gave them their regular Sabbaths and other special Sabbaths throughout the year. God is a God of hard work and a God of rest and fellowship with community. He tells them at this Feast Day to blow the trumpets. The trumpets were blown for many occasions in Israel – when God wanted them to move camp, when they were going to war and when they were going to coronate a King. We don't see any of these things happening in the historical celebration, but they were a foreshadow of what was to come. God always telling us in advance before it happens....

- Jesus Messianic Fulfillment –
- The Feast of Trumpets is in the FALL at the GRAPE and FIG harvests. This is so clearly prophetic to His SECOND COMING, as clearly evidenced by Matthew 24 and Revelation 19.
- It is the 1<sup>st</sup> of the 3 FALL feasts and is only 1 day. This is the day that as they are resting and honoring God and bringing Him an offering, after 7 years of God's wrath being poured down and most of the world being destroyed and people killed, Israel will finally acknowledge Jesus as their Messiah. This will be in 2030 because Jesus died in 30 AD and so has to return in 2000 years.
- Then, His angels will announce Him with a loud trumpet call and the entire world will see and hear Him coming on His white horse what Kings rode, not a colt of a donkey with His Bride on their horses dressed in white the raptured Bride and the tribulation saints.

The sons of Aaron, the priests, are to blow the trumpets. This is to be a lasting ordinance for you and the generations to come.

When you go into battle in your own land against an enemy who is oppressing you, sound a blast on the trumpets.

Then you will be remembered by the LORD your God and rescued from your enemies.

Also, at your times of rejoicing - your appointed festivals and New Moon feasts — you are to sound the trumpets over your burnt offerings and fellowship offerings, and they will be a memorial for you before your God. I am the LORD your God."

- Numbers 10:8-10

Now in the seventh month, on the first day of the month, you shall also have a holy convocation; you shall do no laborious work. It will be to you a day for blowing trumpets.

- Numbers 29:1

At that time (Second Coming of Christ), the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the sky, and all the nations of the earth with mourn. They will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of the sky, with power and great glory. And He will send His angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather His elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.

- Matthew 24:30-31

He will rule them with an iron scepter.
He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God Almighty.
On His robe and on His thigh He has this Name written:
King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

- Revelation 19:15-16

## Feast #6 - Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur):

Points to Jesus returning as the Conquering King of the Jews at the end of the 7 Year Tribulation when Israel finally calls Him Messiah and needs to Atone for their Sins

In Hebrew, Yom Kippur means "Day of Covering or Atoning for Sins"

- FALL 10<sup>th</sup> Day of Tishrei the 7<sup>th</sup> Month So 9 days
  after the Feast of Trumpets, God wanted the Israelites to
  have a solemn day of repenting and fasting a day of
  atoning for their sins, the Feast of Atonement.
- Leviticus 23:26-32, Leviticus 16, Numbers 29:7-11
- Historical significance for Israel God wanted them to start their year and end their year with Him. Thanking Him for His harvests and provisions and repenting and atoning for their sins. He calls us to feast and celebrate and He calls us to rejoice and repent and seek His face, knowing that in all things, in all seasons we need to be in the presence of our God so we will not get taken away by the lusts and evils of the world. When we humble ourselves, HE will lift us up.

- Jesus Messianic Fulfillment
- The Day of Atonement will be 9 days (9 means "it is finished") after Jesus lands on the ground, binds Satan and His demons for 1000 years, kills all of His evil enemies (Revelation 19) and starts His reign as the King of the Jews, the Price of Peace, our High Priest, our Everlasting Counselor!!!
- All Israel as a nation has been hardened since they killed Jesus until they finally acknowledge Him as the Messiah at the end of the 7 Year Tribulation (read Daniel 9 and Romans 11 to understand that it took all that to get them to believe).
- So, on this *Day of Atonement*, they will be kneeling before Him repenting and humbling themselves like Joseph's brothers did in Egypt begging Him for forgiveness and rejoicing in pure joy that HE has already forgiven them and all of human history was to get *Abraham's promise* to get to this point. It will turn from a solemn day of fasting and repenting to pure delight and joy!!! I get chills just thinking about it.

On the tenth day
of this seventh month,
hold a sacred assembly.
You must deny yourselves
and do no work.
Present an aroma pleasing
to the Lord and
make a sin offering
for atonement.

Numbers 29:7-11

You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous person, though for a good person someone might possibly dare to die. **But God demonstrates** HIS own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Since we have **now been justified** by HIS blood, how much more shall we be saved from **God's wrath** through HIM!

- Romans 5:9-10

# Feast #7 - Feast of Tabernacles (Sukkot)

Points to Jesus and the Father tabernacling physically in the Temple from Jerusalem with their People

In Hebrew, Sukkot means "booths or huts"

- FALL the 7<sup>th</sup> Month Tishri 15-22 God started the year with His people and He ends the sacred year 7 months of the harvest season with His people, with a 7-day festival where they would rejoice before the Lord and enjoy community and how God blessed all of the harvests for the past 7 months.
- I love that after God asks His beloved to FAST and REPENT for ONE DAY, HE then commands them to FEAST and CELEBRATE and ENJOY COMMUNITY for SEVEN DAYS! My kind of God! ☺
- Historical significance for Israel To bring the last of the harvest bounty to the Lord and celebrate all that the LORD DID to be the Great Provider and provide for His people through the winter. This was at the GRAPE and FIG harvests - the last and best.
- The Feast of Tabernacles is the 3rd Jewish harvest feast to thank and honor God for all that HE provided, and one they had to travel to Jerusalem to celebrate in community and at the Temple.

 God tells Israel and all of us to remember this by building temporary shelters to live in for 7 days to remember that God was in the tabernacle with them for 40 years as they wandered in the desert.

- Jesus Messianic Fulfillment
- Now the JEWS, His promised heirs to His promise and covenant with Abraham are the THIRD to be united with Christ and "tabernacle" with Him at the 3<sup>rd</sup> major harvest in Israel in the Fall – the GRAPE AND FIG harvest when Israel will finally believe and receive her Messiah.
- Where the term Grapes of Wrath came from and Israel is always symbolized as the FIG TREE in Scripture.
- We will tabernacle live with with God and Jesus for 1000 years in the millennium reign where Israel will be honored and Jesus will reign from Zion.
- All the peoples of the world will flock to the Temple to worship God.

Now on the first day
you shall take for yourselves
the foliage of beautiful trees,
palm branches and
boughs of leafy trees and willows
of the brook, and you shall
rejoice before the Lord your God
for seven days.

- Leviticus 23:40

Then the survivors

from all of the nations
that have attacked
Jerusalem
will go up year after year
to worship the King,
the Lord Almighty and
to celebrate the
Feast of Tabernacles.

- Zechariah 14:16

I saw thrones on which were seated those who had been given authority to judge. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony about Jesus and because of the word of God. They had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Christ a thousand years. (The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended.) This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy are those who share in the first resurrection. The second death has no power over them, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.

- Revelation 20:4-6

- Christ at Unleavened Bread / First Fruits –
  He always models and leads and only
  HE could pay for our sins
- His Bride the Church Pentecost –
   the WHEAT harvest. We go to the mansions He has been preparing and we don't suffer God's WRATH, it is Jacob's Trouble for Israel to get them to finally believe and accept Jesus, and to punish the wicked who refused to accept Jesus
- Israel God's beloved and Abraham's promise Tabernacles – God is once again tabernacling with His people, Israel, in the Temple.

## Exodus 23

#### Three times

(3 is the number for holiness and trinity) you shall keep a Feast to Me in the year: 1) You shall keep the Feast of Unleavened Bread, you shall eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded you, at the time appointed in the month of Nisan (aka Abib), for in it you came out of Egypt; none shall appear before Me empty; 2) and the Feast of Pentecost, the firstfruits of your labors which you have **sown** in the field; 3) and the Feast of Ingathering at the end of the year, when you have gathered in the fruit of your labors from the field.

#### **Jesus 1st Coming**

- 3 Feasts = Holiness, Trinity
- In the FIRST month of the Jewish sacred calendar
  - 1. Passover
  - 2. Feast of Unleavened Bread
    - 3. Feast of First Fruits

#### Jesus 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming for His Bride BEFORE the Wrath


- 1 Feast
- In the middle of the harvest calendar, as the Church was just a deposit until Israel would believe and receive their Messiah
- 4. Pentecost

#### Jesus 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming for Israel as their King

- 3 Feasts = Holiness, Trinity
- In the SEVENTH month of the Jewish sacred calendar
  - 1. Feast of Trumpets
  - 2. Day of Atonement Yom Kippur
    - 3. Feast of Tabernacles
